**Sandusky County Juvenile Justice Center Youth Works Program is accepting applications for a full-time Youth Worker**

Minimum qualifications include: Completion of secondary education with one (1) year training or experience working with; troubled youths and their families; working with young people in a controlled setting, youth services, criminal justice, or related field; prior experience in supervising youth; and/or experience in outdoor education is preferred; valid Ohio driver's license with acceptable driving record. Must be 21 years of age or older at time of appointment and have the ability to establish mature rapport with juveniles.

Work duties include but are not limited to: transporting to and supervising youths at work sites, intake and scheduling of youths, and daily written and oral communication with court staff, and outside agencies. Must establish and maintain an active supporting relationship with Juvenile Court Probation Officers and Juvenile Justice Center Supervisory / Administrative Team.
