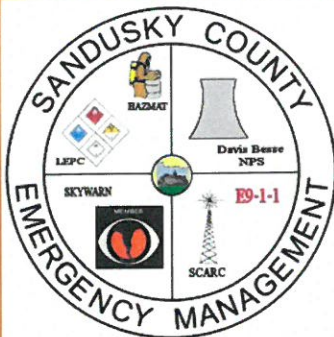

Its that time of year again, cold weather is moving in and its time to turn your heat on. Here are some helpful tips on how to make sure your heat sources are in proper working order.

Baseboard Heaters: Be sure no objects have fallen or are near the heater. Keep furniture a safe distance from the heater. Do not allow electrical cords to drape across the heater.

Portable Heaters: Keep the heater at least three feet away from anything that can burn. Always place them on a flat surface. Always turn the heater off when leaving the room. Avoid using extension cords to plug the heater in.

Fireplaces & Woodstoves: Always use a fire screen to contain sparks. Do not burn rubbish. Keep flammable objects a safe distance from the fireplace. Never leave a fire unattended. Keep clean of ashes.

Be sure to have smoke alarms installed on every level of your home and test them monthly. Have a family plan in the event of a fire and practice the plan with the entire family. Make sure everyone understands that once they have left a burning building, they should never go back inside.
