

Review of External board / Meetings Attended by Commissioners	Commissioner Reiter attended the Sandusky County Visitors Bureau meeting Wednesday. Fremont named one of Ohio's top 5 hometowns in Ohio. Fremont was nominated by an anonymous person. The visitors bureau's current lease on the building is coming to an end and they are looking at an area potentially for them to move out closer to the Ohio Turnpike in hopes to reach more people traveling in and out.			
	Commissioner Zimmerman attended the LEPC meeting on Wednesday. They just finished up the commodity flow study which analyzed the flow of hazardous materials through the county. The report was given to review. The City of Fremont previously had a boat for water rescues they could utilize however they ran into some maintenance issues. LEPC has now purchased a boat which will be kept in Fremont for any fire department or law enforcement agencies in Sandusky County to utilize for any water rescues. 911 update- the CAD project has run into some issues			

	<p>due to capacity for old system to new system. Biggest issue arises in the civil end when they radio dispatch such as for warrants etc. The new system has not had the information necessary for deputies while running information of traffic stops and such warrants etc. As of now they are still utilizing the old system. They have looked into maybe switching vendors for the project however they are unable to do so because of how far the project has come along and the amount of money invested. They are hoping to go live the first week in December. Commissioner Zimmerman suggested that we find a way to put it out to other counties looking to do this CAD upgrade that they have not offered the product promised.</p>			
	<p>Commissioner Reiter attended the Land bank exit interview with the State Auditor. They had a great exit interview which concluded with no findings which is a huge accomplishment because they have just switched systems and generally with any such big changes there is room for error. The report will be available to the public within the next few weeks.</p>			
	<p>Commissioner Reiter also met with Sheriff Hilton to discuss Electronic Monitoring. The Electronic Monitoring department is currently located in the basement of the courthouse. The employees in this department are responsible for placing individuals on community control such as ankle monitors for house arrest and GPS. There are many times when they must meet after hours to complete these set ups and for the sake of security the commissioners believe there needed to be a safer environment for this department. The commissioners have worked with Sheriff Hilton and the Sheriff has identified a location in the communication center which is on Castalia Rd that they believe will be a great office for Electronic Monitoring.</p>



	Deb Didion spoke on behalf of the group who was there in opposition of the AEZ. She spoke of the importance of the Bellevue karst to the area and the damages that could arise with turbines. She had presented the Commissioners with a packet of documents that she had put together with facts on the karst and the turbines. She thanked the commissioners for rescinding the resolution.			
	Pat McCauley was present on behalf of the Department of Treasury and Treasurer Robert Sprague. He spoke of the additional help that is available for the agriculture disaster we have faced this year. Through the AgLink program farmers can get up to \$150k loan and 2% interest reductions for those suffering. The date has been extended until November 15 and anyone who has not utilized the full \$150k are able to reapply for the remaining balance of \$150k. Fliers were given to the commissioners. Pat spoke that Treasurer Sprague wants the citizens to utilize the Treasurer's office as a resource. If they can't assist they will lead you to the person or department that can.			
	Ken Rospert also spoke on behalf of his lifelong residency in Bellevue He addressed the commissioners and city council that was present about the new turbine project that is taking place. He feels they are being landlocked. He wants elected officials to not take a neutral stance but a stance against the turbines.			
	Commissioner Miller spoke to the citizens that they have begun budget workshops for the 2020 year to ensure the			

	<p>county is running efficiently. He also invited everyone to visit the courthouse and informed them of the ramp project that is currently being completed. Scott made note that the census paperwork will be available soon throughout the county and that in 2020 Sandusky County will be celebrating 200 years. Celebrations will be held throughout the year for all age groups. The OSS Director Tim Wasserman is retiring effective 8/31/2019 and the OSS board has been interviewing for his replacement. Some funding issues have taken place over the past year however they seem to be resolving. Contained sewer project in the Wightmans grove district is still on task and Commissioner Zimmerman encouraged everyone to take a look at the state budget. The indigent funds that they have made available to the county is a huge burden lifted as well as additional funding to DJFS office.</p>




