By May 24 <sup>th</sup> they will have a report submitted on the outcome of the forums. One item discussed was how the "right to be heard law" needs to be upheld by the courts. They also talked about the mental support for those who age out of the system. Each county's rules are different for foster care. There is no consistency. There is a need for better training and specifically trauma training for Foster Families. There were some families who have had 58 foster children others had over 100 who have passed through their homes. The law only allows children to be in a Foster Home for two years and they have to move, They mentioned the kinship program and the comment was this needed to be funded too.
