This was discussed at the Elected Officials updates during the ransomware incident. Commissioner Reiter asked what vendor we had issues with when we were recovering from the ransomware incident and if this vendor is dependable if there are issues. Commissioner Reiter stated as long as there is no compromise to our current system is this something the Board will allow our IT Staff to assist in installing.
