He has broken his staff into three squads. This will limit contact between employees. This will be set for two weeks and then re-evaluated. Commissioner Reiter asked Sheriff what he is doing with his School Resource Officers. Sheriff noted he has put them on road patrol. He has also moved security staff around in the Courthouse. Road Patrol is not responding at this time with EMS unless requested. Commissioner Miller asked about the population at the jail. They have been staying steady at 64. 	people moving out as soon as possible. Commissioner Reiter talked about taking temperatures of everyone entering the jail and what the process is if someone has a temperature. If someone does have a temperature they would not be let in and they would then talk to the Jail Doctor on whether or not the individual taking temperatures needs to be quarantined. Commissioner Zimmerman asked Sheriff how he is handling essential vs. non-essential businesses being opened. In particular the question was regarding Whirlpool. The Health Commissioner was going to research this and see if they are truly essential or not. There are other manufacturers that will be researched. Each county needs to adhere to the opinion of their Prosecutor.
