That fee is going to increase from \$.25 to \$.70. It is going to triple the current revenue from this fee. There have been complaints about the Keegan Farm. They are stacking things in the yard again and they wanted to know what could be done. Unfortunately they are not regulated by anyone. A group of officials are going out to the farm to look at the farm and see what's going on and what they can do. The fire departments were given conversion charts for hazardous chemicals. 
