I. Placements

- a. Current custody: 16 (17 last month). Adoption occurred 9/20
 - i. Safe reductions: another adoption by end of year.
 - ii. Annual costs continue to remain low, the number in care remains low.
 - iii. Reimbursement at pandemic rate is 6% higher, will return back and increase county portion in 2023

II. Building / Staffing status

- a. Child welfare retention dollars spending, the state fully approved our plan: will be doing a large one time stipend for staff, and training incentives. Received another allocation for two additional divisions, will do a much smaller scale stipend for them, and will be able to cover the rest of the building with a stipend.
- b. We have adjusted non bargaining pay scale- to go from a worker ssw4 to management as a trainer would be less pay, with formulas and a method to the step increases. We also revamped on call management pay. Longevity has been updated, the prior longevity in place since 1996 was not worth the paper and time it wasted to give a 4 cent raise. Of course this all still fiscally fits well within our budget.
- c. Building spaces- new fraud office and moving the workout room to the workroom. Slow moving.
- d. Peer mentor is in place, will be able to take our first START case after October 20, ahead of schedule, we were hoping by end of year.
