



Ratio of PM to CM by Year




Trend: Past 3 Years based on Completed Date

Total # of WOs by Year




Trend: Past 3 Years based on Created Date (Includes Reactive and PM Wo's)

Avg Hours by Year




Trend: Past 3 Years based on Created Date

Avg WOs Per Technician by Year




Trend: Past 3 Years based on Created Date
